Charlottesville is widely-advertised as one of the best places in the country to live. The presence of PVCC contributes to that status. PVCC provides so many avenues to learning and success-- avenues that I have personally seen. PVCC provides 2 year degrees, access to 4 year degrees, opportunities for adult learners to restart their college experience, workplace training, learning opportunities for elementary through high school and many, many more opportunities. I love PVCC, both for what it has done for me-- allowing me to continue my education after failure-- and for what it offers our community.

Each Monday during the school year I go to PVCC's cafeteria to be available for young people I mentor through my non-profit, Building Experiences. Each fall new students come from the area high schools and are a little sad that they are not heading off to the 4 year college experience that they are sure their peers are enjoying. Over the next two years, they develop relationships with professors, master the rhythm of the college semester, join clubs of interest and transfer to 4-year schools. This is when they truly begin to appreciate PVCC. These first-generation, low-income students finally understand the value of the affordable education available to them in their hometown. After 2 years of PVCC, fully covered by grants and scholarships, they matriculate to schools where each year they must provide another \$5,000 out of pocket to cover room, board and fees-- on top of the thousands of dollars of subsidized and unsubsidized loans they take out each year.

PVCC has always been a gem in this community, but its importance now is absolutely critical to the low-income youth of our region. People are finally realizing the severity of the student loan debt crisis, and the particular burden it places on families who are low-income. PVCC provides incredibly value in all of its pathways, and this should be more clearly communicated to our community-- especially at the grade school level and in college preparedness programs.

If appointed to the PVCC board, I would be proud to serve an agency that provides access and opportunity to learners of all economic backgrounds, and provides so much value to our community. I would be eager to develop new ways to disseminate information about PVCC to high schools, partner with businesses to provide relevant internship and training opportunities, and engage with PVCC students, faculty, alumni and staff. I am an enthusiastic advocate for PVCC already, and serving on the board would give me a greater platform to lobby for access and excellence for the PVCC community.
