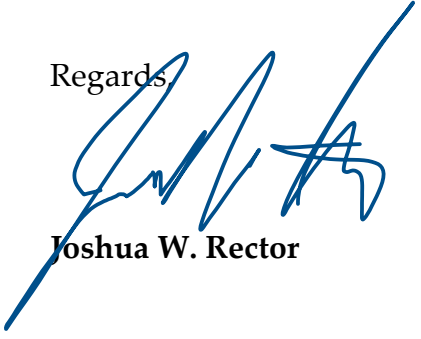
Per our email and phone conversations, I am writing you officially to request the approval to change “Ringwood Farm PVT” to one of the bellow preferred alternatives. Also per our conversation pertinent information is as follows:

1. The location of the road (nearest intersection, parcel identification number of the property served, etc.).
 - a. The existing Ringwood Farm rd. has two intersections with public roads one at White Hall Rd. (810) and one with Browns Gap Tpke. (680).
 - b. Parcel ID number (04000-00-00-03900)
 - c. This serves 4 addresses in total, all of whom are owned by one ownership.\
 - i. 2662 Ringwood Farm
 - ii. 2640 Ringwood Farm
 - iii. 2656 Ringwood Farm
 - iv. 2664 Ringwood Farm

2. The proposed name for the road.
 - a. Preferred Names in Ranked Order:
 - i. Nags Head Farm PVT
 - ii. Nags Head Farm Lane
 - iii. Nags Head Farm Rd.
 - iv. NHF Farm Rd.
 - v. NHF Lane
3. Acknowledgement that the landowner will be responsible for the cost of the new road sign, since this is a name change initiated by the landowner.
 - a. I as the contract purchaser will pay for the change in road signs upon approval.
4. Signatures of the affected landowners
 - a. As of our closing on Dec 1st 2017 the property is owned by Nags Head Farm LLC, My wife and I are the owners of Nags Head Farm LLC and I am the Manger of the LLC, so my signature on this letter should suffice, the other address's affected are rental properties owned fully by Nags Head Farm LLC.
