



## Monticello Area Community Action Agency (MACAA)

MACAA, under Mrs. Arsali's leadership, took on several major tasks. Namely, MACAA engaged with community partners to explore the sale of just over seven acres of real estate in the City of Charlottesville with the expressed goal of supporting, serving, and meeting the needs of families experiencing low income. Not only did Mrs. Arsali serve as Chair of the Board of Directors during this time, she also served on the Real

Estate Development Task Force and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Task Force. Her experience as an educator and engaged community member have been a tremendous asset to the agency's governance efforts.

In addition to these significant accomplishments, MACAA has worked to begin serving pregnant women and children ages birth to three in Early Head Start (\$1.4M competitive grant awarded in March 2021). Mrs. Arsali has been integral in oversight of these efforts to ensure the most vulnerable students in the greater Charlottesville area are served.
