






The Project


- Public / Private Partnership project that includes VDOT Revenue Sharing Funds
- Provides road connections consistent with 2021 Crozet Master Plan:

"Additional street "connections" should also be provided in areas where streets currently stub out or where there is an obvious opportunity for improved connectivity with streets ending just shy of an adjacent roadway. These connections are expected to be made if, and when adjacent properties redevelop."



The Project

- Project Budget \$8,093,351
- Current Phase / Status In Right-of-Way Phase
- Construction Bidding Phase June 2025
- Construction Duration 12 months from Notice to Proceed




The Parcel






The Parcel

- Parcel 56A2-04—A3
- 0.07 acres
- Currently an unused stub of the western terminus of Hill Top Street in Parkside Village
- Initially thought to be owned by Parkside Village HOA




The Parcel (ctd.)

- Actually owned by Hauser Homes, Inc., a defunct Virginia corporation
- Title has transferred by law to the Unknown Trustees in Liquidation of that company
- Company (and therefore Parcel) are further subject to multiple judgments
- Eminent domain is only practical way to acquire clear title, needed for project to proceed




The Process

- Board adopts proposed resolution (Attachment B).
- With assistance of outside counsel, County files
 Certificate of Take and deposits estimated value of Parcel (\$900) with Court.
- County immediately acquires clear title, can proceed with project.
- Court ultimately determines value of Parcel and proper recipients of payment.


