



## CDBG Program

Federally funded, administered by the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)

Funding for projects that meet three national objectives

- Activities benefiting low- and moderate-income persons
- Activities which aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight
- Activities designed to meet community needs having a particular urgency

#### Requires two public hearings

- Public hearing #1 held August 6, 2025
- Public hearing #2 held August 20, 2025



## 2025 CDBG Funding

#### Calendar Year 2025

• \$16,313,103 available for competitive grant applications

### Albemarle County eligible funding amount:

Up to \$2 million




## Proposed Project


#### Southwood Sanitary Sewer Services Project

- Installation of approximately 3,000 linear feet of new sanitary sewer main
- Installation of three lateral connections to public sewer main

#### Beneficiaries:

63 households/approximately 233 individuals





## Proposed Budget & Timeline

### **Budget**

CDBG	\$2,000,000
Construction	\$1,875,000
Admin	\$ 125,000
HABITAT	\$1,735,000
TOTAL	\$3,735,000

### Timeline

Engineering/design: December 2025

Permits: April 2026

Easements: April 2026

Bid Procurement: October 2026

Construction start: January 2027

Project completion: April 2028




## Staff Recommendation
