





Overview

- Virginia Supportive Housing Premier Circle Permanent Supportive Housing
- Habitat for Humanity of Greater Charlottesville – Southwood Cardinal Hill Apartments







- 80 studio units for persons experiencing chronic homelessness
- Includes provision of on-site and off-site supportive services
- Part of larger affordable housing project comprising 140 affordable units
- Partnership with Piedmont Housing Alliance,
 Blue Ridge Area Coalition for the Homeless



- Funding raised: \$22.6 million
- Total request: \$1.4 million
- Funding recommendation: \$700,000
- Total county funding commitment (if approved):
 \$4.85 million or 22% of total project cost
 - \$2.4 million ARPA funds
 - \$700,000 Housing Fund Reserve
 - \$1.75 million for 28 Project Based Vouchers (estimated worth)



Alignment with County policies:

- Strategic Plan Goal 4: Quality of Life –
 Encourage a vibrant community with economic and recreational opportunities that serve all community members.
- Housing Albemarle Objective 10: Work to end and prevent homelessness.







- 14 units of affordable rental housing
- Focus on hardest-to-rehouse Southwood residents, & senior residents
- Rents affordable to households with incomes at or below 80% AMI. Some flexibility in income for relocation purposes
- Affordable for 30-year period



- Total project costs: \$5,118,316
- Total request: \$1.5 million
- Funding recommendation: \$1.5 million
- Total county funding commitment (if approved): \$1,806,584 or 35% of total project cost

- Housing Albemarle Objective 2: Increase the supply of affordable and workforce rental housing in Albemarle County.
