Summary

I believe that the combination of my (i) service to date on the Airport Commission, (ii) deep knowledge of the Airport and its challenges over the next five years (iii) inclination to community service and (iv) business acumen and experience make me the best candidate for the joint appointee position.

Our airport is an important asset to our community. It needs to serve the flying and tax paying public and through continued amenity improvements while maintaining a balanced budget. Critical issues over the next five years include addressing a growing need for parking, benefiting from the change in CHO's revenue model and continuing the upgrades of facilities through state and federal agency funding to attract passengers and airlines.

Commission service

I have served on the Airport Commission since December 2014 with unblemished in-person attendance record. I have volunteered to take on additional responsibilities as Chair of the Audit Committee. I refer you to our Chairman, Dr. John Post, as to my contribution to productive meetings and a high level of Commissioner education and engagement.

Five-year challenges at CHO

Fiscal responsibility and revenue model change - The airport takes no money from either the city or county and there is no reason that that fiscal position should change. However, the airport is without any meaningful financial reserves and will adopt a new revenue model with respect to airline charges in the next fiscal year. Balancing the fees among (a) parking passengers, (b) rental car agencies and (c) airlines while at the same time offering a compelling value to each as well as building financial reserves will require careful financial planning and management.

Parking - The airport is consuming surface parking area at a steady pace and will soon exhaust the easy expansion solutions. Developing a parking deck solution will require the use of thoughtful traffic and parking rate forecasts as well as assuring the parking passengers that a comprehensive solution will be an upgrade to the current parking options. Prudence dictates that a downside scenario of reduced passenger traffic (due to airline cutbacks or comparatively stronger travel values at nearby airports) be considered in evaluating the cost, timing and design of parking plans.

Government and agency relations - The FAA and the Virginia Board of Aviation can be powerful allies in keeping CHO at the forefront of regional airports. Currently, CHO receives well over 75% of its funding for capital projects from government entities. We need to work cooperatively with these and other agencies to take advantage of the capital available for the betterment of safety and facilities that benefit the flying public.

Amenities - Since the current terminal was constructed, the nature of air travel has changed. Expectations for Wi-Fi, meal service, water stations, family restrooms, covered parking access, business centers, ATMs, baggage handling etc. are markedly different from two decades ago. Meeting regulatory requirements including TSA, firefighting, security, runway markings, etc. is essential. All of these "have to haves" and "nice to haves" must be prioritized, ranked and implemented with the goal of long term value and sustainability for the airport's key constituencies.

Airport Usage

I have kept a plane at CHO since 1992 and I use CHO multiple times per week. I hold an Airline Transport Pilot rating (used as an avocation, rather than as a vocation), own an airplane and a hangar and am president of my hangar association. I am well familiar with the benefits offered by Landmark Aviation and the private aviation infrastructure.

I travel commercially by air every other month and am always interested in comparing and benchmarking our services with better-known airports such as Richmond, Dulles, and European hub airports, for example.

Community service

At this stage in my life, community service is my principal quasi-professional activity. In addition to my service on the Airport Commission, I am Treasurer and President-elect of Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Virginia and a Trustee Tandem Friends School of Charlottesville. I am free of work commitments and intend to stay in that position for some time.

Professional

My expertise in a wide variety of professional setting comes down to providing leadership and guidance to growing organizations. My functional expertise is in finance and I believe in light of the challenges over the next five years, such experience is essential. To be clear, however, I understand that work gets done *through* people and the better the people that are involved, the better the outcome that will be obtained.
