Thanked Albemarle County staff, and police and fire rescue staff, for the tour of the Public Safety Operations Center. <p><u>Diantha McKeel:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Commented on the tour of the Public Safety Operations Center and noted that the center provided relief for the 5th Street Fire Station. <p><u>Ann Mallek:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remarked that it took 10 years of work through the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to bring the Public Safety Operations Center to completion. Commented on the Long Range Transportation Plan vision list and constrained list, and encouraged Board members to submit their comments. Commented on two interactive database resources: a Census Bureau tool called On the Map, and the Virginia Hazard Mitigation Plan. Mentioned that the American Farmland Trust Advisory Committee tool kit would be coming out within the next year as a planning resource for those involved in agriculture in Virginia. <p><u>Bea LaPisto-Kirtley:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Commented that the Stony Point Volunteer Fire Company has already benefitted from the new Public Safety Operations Center by allowing them to build a brush fire truck in house and it is now at the Stony Point station.
