5th & Avon	Bus shelter at 5th Street & Old Lynchburg Road
	Bus shelter at 5th St. & Country Green
	Bus stops in the 5th Street Extended area (Old Lynchburg, Sunset, etc.)
	Public transportation bus stop @ Mill Creek Drive and Avon St.
	Bus stop enhancements, including benches/shelters/trash cans/concrete pads
	Establish a new CAT bus stop with a bus shelter and street light at the corner of Avon St Extended and Mill Creek Dr in the right hand turn lane to Mill Creek Subdivision.
Crozet	Transportation Network Study (/mobility study) including parking, bus, transit, sidewalks
Pantops	Bus stop enhancements (shelter) for low-income and transit-dependent residents (Route 20, Giant Shopping Center)
	Street lights on Route 250 and Route 20 (to Darden Towe Park), especially for safety on bus stop paths
Hydraulic	Bus shelter/stop improvements on Commonwealth, Street lighting (solar)
	Bus stops for Commonwealth, Greenbrier, Four Seasons, Georgetown
	Add bus stops closer to schools
	Add bus stop for the food bank
	Lighting and covering bus stops (improve existing)
	Reduce # of existing bus stops – they are clustered too closely
	Add a bus stop closer to the 3 schools (Albemarle, Jouett, Greer) – closest one is mid-way on Georgetown Road
	Bus shelters for the stops along Georgetown Rd.
	Major investment in bus shelters on east and west portions of Commonwealth Drive by Turtle Creek
	Bus Stop Enhancements
North	Add bus stop shelters and benches at existing bus stops in the area
Rio	provide bike/ped connections to transit
	Bus Stop Enhancements, Provide benches, shelters, concrete pads, trash cans, etc. at various strategic and high volume locations
