The 2019 Annual Business Meeting of the Virginia Association of Counties will be held on Tuesday, November 12, at 9:00 a.m. at the Omni Homestead in Bath County.

Article VI, VACo Bylaws, states that each county shall designate a representative of its board of supervisors to cast its vote(s) at the Annual Business Meeting.

However, if a member of the board of supervisors cannot be present for this meeting, the Association's Bylaws allow a county to designate a non-elected official from your county or a member of a board of supervisors from another county to cast a proxy vote(s) for your county.

For your county to be certified to vote at the Annual Business Meeting, (1) your annual dues must be paid in full and (2) either a completed Voting Credentials Form or a Proxy Statement must be submitted to VACo by November 1, 2019. Alternatively, this information may be submitted to the **Credentials Committee at its meeting on Monday, November 11, at 1:00 p.m. in the Monroe Room** or to the conference registration desk before this meeting.
