I have asked county staff (Kevin) if there were any views in particular that they would like sims completed from, but he is on vacation until next Monday. Once I hear back I will let you know about sims.

As for the site location, there are a couple close by that I know are fairly easy to go look at. Please keep in mind some of these are older sites that may not be fenced since at the time they were built that was not a requirement.

1. Three poles including one (1) Verizon pole located along Dry Bridge Road, just north of Dicks Woods Road and before you get to I-64.

2. Verizon Pole located near intersection of I-64 and Route 29. From 29 south turn left (First Left after going under I64) onto Teel Lane and then continue left past the park and ride. Continue down the road until you reach the VDOT Storage area, and the site is located just down the gravel road to the right near the train tracks. Site is a wood pole but not fenced.

3. Verizon pole located near the Route 250/I64 entrance near Crozet. Coming from Crozet, turn left onto Patterson Mill Lane (First Left after coming under 64). Continue down the road till you come to the entrance of 203/205 Patterson Mill Road. Turn into the entrance and then turn first right onto gravel road and follow to you come to the gate for the tower on the left. Tower is close to 64, cannot really see it from the Patterson Mill Road or I64.

4. Verizon pole located behind Wegmans at Fifth Street Station in Charlottesville. This one is a little different as the fenced tower compound and the monopole are located in different spots on the property. This pole was built in the last year and half.
