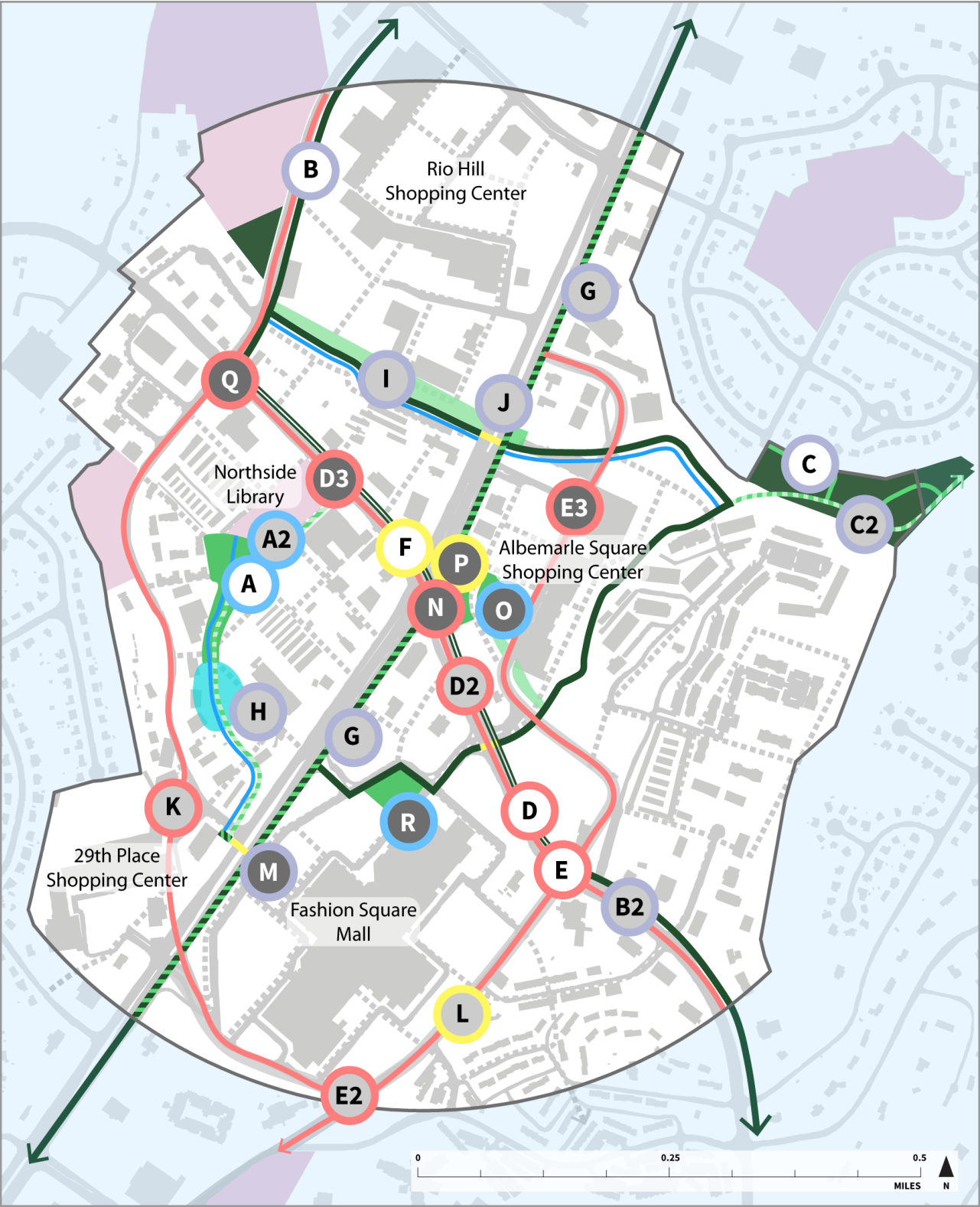


RIO29 SMALL AREA PLAN
