We have been waiting for the county to provide bus service to the Hollymead Town Center. In 2007, the County of Albemarle, Department of Community Development gave zoning clearance for the Hollymead Town Center, provided Octagon Partners (Wendell Wood) proffered \$50,000/year for 10 years to be used for bus service to serve that area. The Octagon Partners also were required to add a bus stop to the center. I have lived in Jefferson Village and have yet to see bus service in Hollymead Town Center. So I presume this funding has not been used and is waiting in your coffers.

This wait is over. Since this demand to the builders for public bus funding has already been approved, this implies that bus service was already approved. With the increased traffic on 29 and the dangers created by this traffic to all our neighborhoods, our citizens deserve an alternate way to travel into Charlottesville.

For transparency, I am requesting the whereabouts of these funds. Further, I am asking for bus service to be extended to the Hollymead Town Center by November 1<sup>st</sup> of this year, 2015. In time for the holiday season.

Please explain if for some unknown reason, these funds can not be located nor accounted for.
