



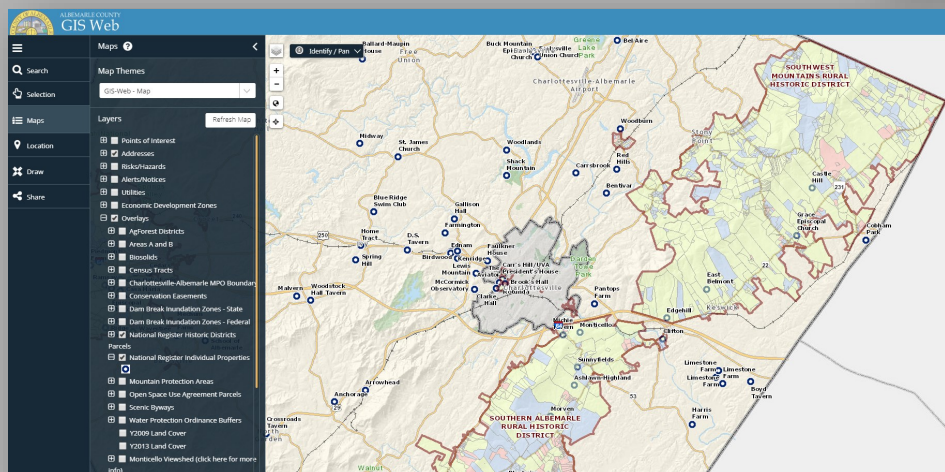

Albemarle County Historic Preservation Committee

2018 | We educated, preserved, interpreted, documented and connected to serve this unique community



**ACCOMPLISHMENT:** the Committee re-researched the history of the Rio Mills and Cartersburg areas and mounted an analog display of the findings in the County Office Building during Preservation Week as well as added it to the digital display on the first floor of the County Office Building. The work provides some context for the Rio29 Small Area Plan, and the Committee hopes to convert the work into content for exhibits and historic markers.

**ACCOMPLISHMENT:** Findowrie, built ca. 1785, the oldest and most intact historic resource in the County, was privately purchased and will be saved. Members of the Historic Preservation Committee met with the new owner prior to purchase and discussed various incentives in investing in this historic resource's future.



**ACCOMPLISHMENT:** Two new layers were added to GIS Web that identify the County's historic resources that are individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places and which contribute to the County's 11 National Register of Historic Places Historic Districts.

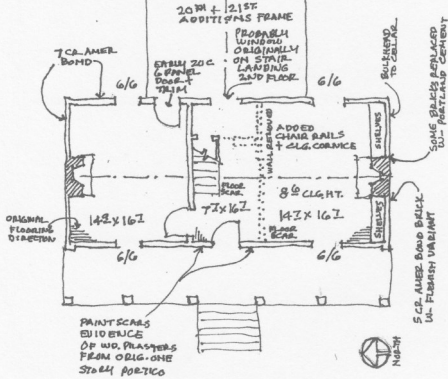

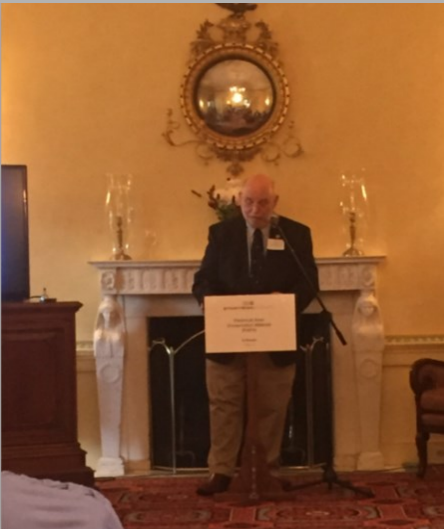

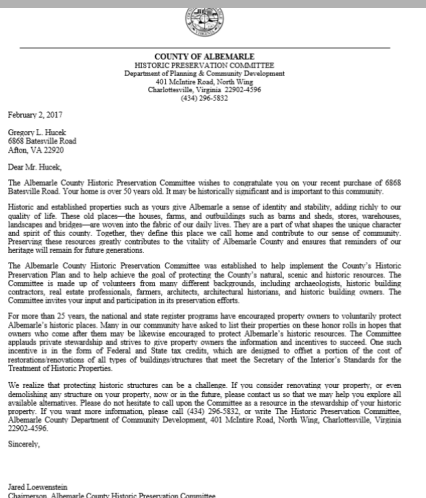
