Avon St. Ext. (Rt. 742)	Yes - Entire segment (City limits to Rt. 20)	No	5 th /Avon CAC did not object to EC standards, but had concerns about conflicts between arterial standards and recommendations of the recently completed Corridor Study.
Barracks Rd. (Rt. 654)	Yes - City limits to Georgetown Road (non-arterial west of Georgetown Rd.)	County Scenic Highway beyond Georgetown Road	Current designation is to Old Garth Road, but early VDOT input indicates support only for extending to the Georgetown intersection.
Irish Rd. (Rt. 6)	No	County Scenic Highway	-
TJ Parkway (Rt. 53)	Yes - Entire segment (Rt. 20 to Fluvanna County line; an alternative is Rt. 20 to Rt. 795)	County Historic District, County Scenic Highway	In preliminary discussions, VDOT didn't believe the character of the road supports an arterial request, but the historic character of the corridor is strong.
5th St. Ext./ Old Lynchburg Rd. (Rt. 631) beyond Sunset Ave.	No	County Scenic Highway	-
Louisa Rd. (Rt. 22)	No	County Scenic Highway	-
Richmond Rd. (Rt. 250 East)	Yes - Entire segment (city line to Fluvanna County line)	No	VDOT believes it makes sense to pursue arterial status through Goochland
Stony Point Rd. (Rt. 20)	No	County Scenic Highway	-
