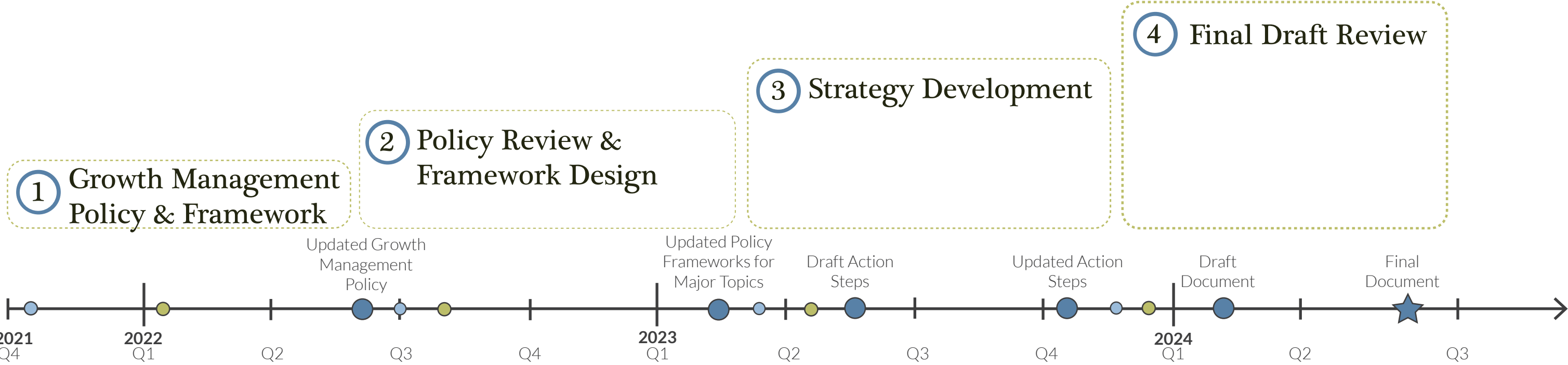


Albemarle County Comprehensive Plan Update | Project Goals & Phasing Plan



OVERALL PROJECT GOALS

- This project seeks to complete a focused and timely update of the 2015 Comprehensive Plan, to achieve the following goals:
- Update plan content to reflect recent County-wide strategic initiatives including climate action planning, economic development, and multi-modal transportation planning
 - Ensure that equity is integrated into the engagement process and the updated plan content, consistent with the County’s recently added “Community” organizational value (*Community: We expect diversity, equity and inclusion to be integrated into how we live our mission.*)
 - Improve Plan usability by articulating clearly prioritized goals, incorporating metrics for tracking progress, and applying a modern, streamlined document design.

Staff anticipates that additional goals will be added based on Board, PC, and community input.

1 Growth Management Plan & Framework (Q4 2021 - Q2 2022)

- To review, evaluate, and update the Growth Management Policy through the lenses of equity, climate action, capacity projections.
- To align Comprehensive Plan Vision & Values to align with Albemarle County’s updated Values
- To identify level of detail in the Plan and develop framework approach

2 Policy Review & Framework Design (Q2 2022 - Q1 2023)

- To identify core/major topics of the Comprehensive Plan, evaluate existing conditions for each major topic, and update policy statements and/or frameworks through the lenses of equity and climate action.
- Anticipated major topics include: Transportation, Economic Development, Land Use, Resource and Rural Area Planning.

3 Strategies & Actions (Q1 2023 - Q4 2023)

- To review and update Albemarle County’s strategies (“action steps”) and implementation approach through the lenses of equity and climate action
- Anticipated deliverables include: Updated Future Land Use Plan & Multimodal Systems Plan

4 Final Draft Review (Q4 2023 - Q2 2024)

- To combine, refine, and finalize Comprehensive Plan document, incorporating public, Planning Commission, and Board of Supervisors feedback
