Roger Schickedantz is a Director, project manager, and architect at William McDonough + Partners where he has worked for 25 years.

At the firm, he has led many groundbreaking projects well known for their accomplishments in the field of sustainable architecture, including Herman Miller's "Greenhouse" factory and the Environmental Studies Center at Oberlin College. Recently completed buildings include a motorcycle factory and an R&D center in India for Hero MotoCorp, and the Southside Soapbox factory in Chicago for Method Home.

Green roofs have been a distinctive feature in the work of WM+P since 1994, starting with the building now serving as YouTube's headquarters. Roger has led the firm's evolution in green roof technology, from the 10-acre Ford Rouge Plant rooftop completed in 2003 to the hydroponic greenhouses recently occupied by Gotham Greens in Chicago.

Current work includes an academic building for the Universidad EAN in Bogotá, Colombia. Roger speaks often on the work of William McDonough + Partners and the Cradle to Cradle® philosophy, highlighting the firm's focus on beneficial, regenerative environments.
