

## Attachment B Draft Prioritization

Prioritization ranking for the County to initiate proceedings that could include repair or demolition/removal of part or all of a structure:

### Structurally unsound

1. Some or all of structure could fall and could cause injury or death to members of the public (exclusive of trespassers)
2. Some or all of structure could fall and cause damage to neighboring property improvements or public property, including roads. (This relates to improvements, not just falling on other property.)
3. Some or all of structure could fall and trespass on other property

### Structure in pieces or unsound so as to potentially lead to impacts

4. Discharge to or other impact to nearby stream, so as to potentially impact stream quality and/or quality of area wells. (This may be a Fire/Rescue lead or a State agency lead, depending on the situation.)

### Aesthetics – no public health or safety conditions (#1-4) apply

5. Visible from public road (entrance corridor)
6. Visible from public road

### Lowest Priority

7. Aesthetics - Visible from neighbor's property.

First four categories prioritized in all cases. Additional cases are prioritized with aging urban neighborhoods (over 30 years old) .
