

Capital Projects Status Report 4th Quarter CY 2016

February 1, 2017

The Project Management Division (PMD) of the Facilities & Environmental Services Department is pleased to present the fourth quarter Capital Projects Status Report for calendar year 2016. The report provides summary level information on all projects managed by PMD, including both Capital Projects and Capital Maintenance Projects.

The dedicated PMD Team worked on thirty-three (33) active County projects in the 4th quarter of 2016. Substantial Completion was achieved on the Darden Towe Park Tennis Courts project, the Scottsville Library Renovations and the Red Hill E.S. Modernization project while project close-out took place on another twelve (12) school projects.

Notable projects currently under construction include: South Pantops Drive/State Farm Boulevard Sidewalk; Jack Jouett Middle School Security Improvements; and the Preddy Creek Park Bridge.

Notable projects that are in the design and / or bidding stage: Pantops Station 16, Rescue 8 Addition and Renovations, Hydraulic / Barracks Road Sidewalk project, Hollymead Dam and the Woodbrook Elementary School Additions and Renovations.

The FES Director and PMD Chief have been working with an architectural firm on studies related to the Courts, and assisting Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority with the design of the Ivy Material Utilization Center.

The following sections provide a summary on all projects and more detailed information of select Capital Projects. Project budget trackers continue to be included for the select projects that are reported on individually in the quarterly report.

Project: Jack Jouett Middle School Security Improvements

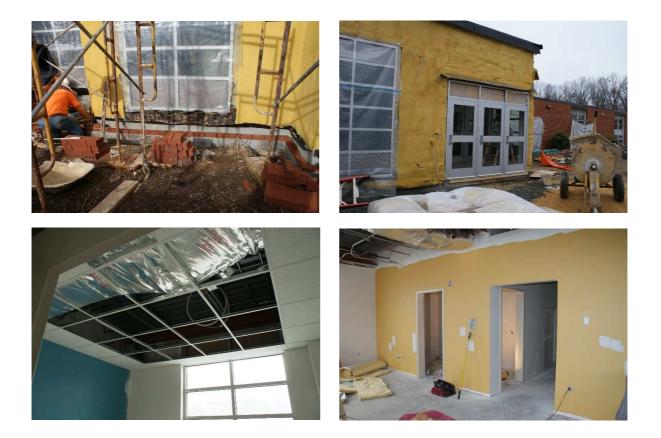
Description:

This projects consists of building a single story addition and selected minor renovations at the Jouett Middle School.

Status:

The design phase was handled by the School's Building Services Department and handed-off to the Project Management Division for the construction phase. A Notice to Proceed was issued to the contractor on July 18, 2016, and work commenced on August 8, 2016. There was a schedule delay due to the hazardous materials discovered at the start of construction that had to be abated. This work was completed on August 14, 2016. The window panels, doors, electrical and maintenance rough-in has been completed. Brickwork, door hardware, painting, and ceiling panels are underway. Substantial Completion is anticipated for February 1, 2017.

Description:

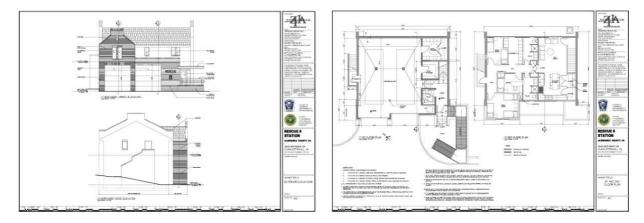
This projects consists of planning, design, and construction of renovations to the existing station which includes renovation of approximately 2,730 square feet of the existing rescue squad building, an addition of approximately 300 square feet to enlarge the bay for current apparatus, and restoration/ replacement of the existing parking lot.

Status:

Bids were received on November 14, 2016 and exceeded budget by \$50,493. Potential cost savings and value engineering options have been discussed with staff, architect, and contractor. These options will be submitted to the contractor for a revised quote. The plans did not originally include a sprinkler system, but the project manager has now confirmed with the Deputy Building Official that a system is required. An estimate for this change is currently being reviewed. Construction for this project will take approximately five months. There is a distinct possibility that this project will be re-bid.

Project: Pantops Station 16

Description:

This project consists of design and construction of an approximately 9,880 square foot public safety facility with three apparatus bays (2 for fire engines or rescue vehicles and 1 for ambulance or small rescue vehicle) and support facilities for 13 personnel, including office, training, equipment, and bunk space. Land was donated for its use at 656 Peter Jefferson Parkway in the Pantops area to serve the Pantops Mountain Urban Area (Neighborhood 3) and indirectly service the rest of the County.

Status:

Bids were received on December 1, 2016 and exceeded budget by \$335,000. Project Manager is currently working with the Architect and Contractor on value engineering items. Kenbridge Construction Company Inc. is the current low bidder on the project. The value engineering options identified do not change the operation or the layout of the facility. Additional sources of funding have been identified, in addition to value engineering options, and these will go to the Board for approval on February 1, 2017. The additional sources of funding include proffers for \$63,650 and remaining balances of \$298,638 identified through project close out procedures.

Project: Crozet Avenue North, South Pantops Drive and State Farm Boulevard Sidewalk Improvements

Description:

This Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing project supports pedestrian safety by providing sidewalk improvements along Crozet Avenue North, South Pantops Drive and State Farm Boulevard. The Crozet Avenue North portion of the project provides 1,110 LF of sidewalk construction between St. George Ave and Crozet Elementary School; including concrete curb and sidewalk, storm piping, drop inlets, and waterline relocation. The State Farm Boulevard portion of the project provides 660 LF of sidewalk construction between Richmond Road and Hickman Road, including concrete curb and sidewalk, storm piping, and drop inlets. The South Pantops Drive portion of the project provides 600 LF of sidewalk construction along South Pantops Drive, including concrete curb and sidewalk, storm piping, and drop inlets.

Status:

The Crozet Avenue North sidewalk phase of the project achieved final completion on September 28, 2016. Work on the State Farm Boulevard/South Pantops Drive sidewalk phase of the project began on October 15, 2016. The work was completed on State Farm Boulevard/South Pantops Drive. Kimley-Horn and Associates rejected the paving due to not matching the specifications provided. The repaving has been completed and approved. This phase of the project's substantial completion is anticipated the week of January 16, 2017. *Update Note: Substantial Completion for original contract work was achieved on 1/19/17.*

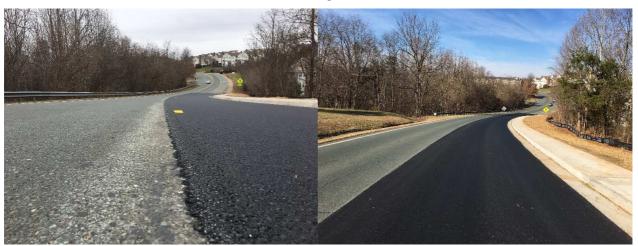

Project: Hydraulic Road and Barracks Road Sidewalk Improvements

Description:

This Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing project supports pedestrian safety by providing sidewalk improvements along Hydraulic Road and Barracks Road. The Hydraulic Road sidewalk improvement involves the construction of approximately 1,700 feet of sidewalk on the north side of Hydraulic Road from the existing sidewalk at the Stonefield Shopping Center to Georgetown Road. The Barracks Road sidewalk improvement involves: 1) the construction of approximately 1,000 feet of sidewalk from the Barracks West apartments on the north side of Barracks Road to the existing sidewalk west of the Georgetown Road intersection; and 2) the construction of crosswalk and a segment of sidewalk (225 ft. total) on the south side between Georgetown Road intersection and Westminster Road.

Negotiations with final two owners ongoing. *Update Note: Final two property owners on Barracks Road signed acquisition agreements on 1/19/17.*

Description:

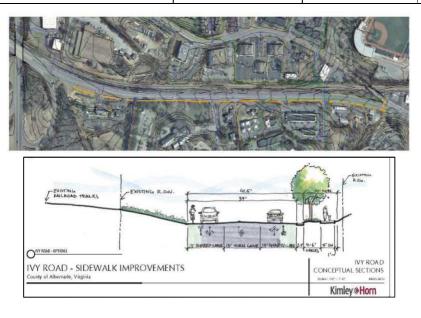
This Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing project supports pedestrian safety by providing sidewalk along Ivy Road from the existing sidewalk at the Charlottesville City limits to Stillfried Lane with a potential future extension along the UVA property to the Route 29/250 Bypass interchange. The project includes crosswalks and pedestrian signals at the Old Ivy Road (railroad underpass) and Ivy Road intersection along with bike lane facilities, curb & gutter, storm drainage system improvements and consideration for possible street trees and pedestrian lighting.

Status:

Received Executive approval of a change order to increase consultant's project order (contract) more than 25% in order to provide services from Public Hearing through Construction (City limits to Stillfried Lane). The current project order covered services through the Public Hearing Design Plans. As a reminder, at their January 6, 2016 meeting, the Board directed staff to proceed with the design of the project from the City of Charlottesville limits to Stillfried Lane and to phase the construction to maximize the amount of sidewalk that may be built within the budget.

Reviewing, coordinating, and responding to VDOT Public Hearing plan comments. Kimley-Horn is currently working with VDOT Traffic Division on the pedestrian crossing configuration and the signal modifications plan at the Ivy Road/Old Ivy Road/S. Anne's School exit intersection. Planning is in progress to conduct a Public Hearing in March 2017.

Project: Rio Road, Avon Street, and Route 250W-Crozet Sidewalk Improvements

Description:

This Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) Revenue Sharing project supports pedestrian safety by providing sidewalk improvements along Rio Road, Avon Street, and US 250 West (Rockfish Gap Turnpike). The Right-of-Way Plans and drainage calculations submitted to VDOT for review on December 22, 2016. To maintain the flexibility of the current program agreement, PMD will wait until the Right-of-Way Phase to make a decision on whether to request VDOT split the project into 3 projects.

At the December 14, 2016 Board meeting, Board approved including a mid-block pedestrian crossing on US-250W between Radford Lane and Clover Lawn Lane and transfer of a portion of the remaining Meadow Creek Parkway revenue sharing funds to support construction. Once this funding is received from VDOT, an appropriation will be requested to move the money to this project's budget. The updated appendixes are being routed for signatures.

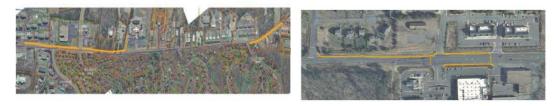

Project: Preddy Creek Park Bridge

Description:

This projects consists of providing both pedestrian/hiker/biker and equestrian access across Preddy Creek to the recently acquired Preddy Creek Park expansion lands. Pedestrian access across the creek will be accomplished via a cable-supported suspension bridge that is approximately 80-ft long and 4-ft wide. A new ford will be constructed to allow equestrian and emergency vehicle access across the creek.
