

2443 Albemarle County residents were served by Region Ten in Fiscal Year 2016.



- 73% with MH




Adult's Top Three Axis 1 Diagnoses:

Children's Top Three Axis 1 Diagnoses:


- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorders

Ongoing Needs


- Case Management continues to have a growing list of demands imposed by regulatory requirements
- Medical Services (Psychiatry): This service continues to operate at a deficit of \$836,453 annually. This represents an increased deficit of \$200,314 from FY 15.
- ► Emergency Services: This service operates at an annual deficit of \$1,023,937. This represents an increased deficit of \$273,859 from FY 15.
- ▶ 25 out of 69 programs operated by Region Ten require additional support from unrestricted funds.



Albemarle County Return on Investment

- ➤ 2443 Albemarle County residents were served at a total annual cost of \$9,502,121.
- The FY 2017 Albemarle County appropriation is \$573,611.

Region Ten's Albemarle County consumers experienced the following in FY 16:

- ► Increase in individuals served: 7 percent
- Increase in individuals utilizing Mental Health Services: 5 percent
- Increase in individuals utilizing Intellectual and Developmental Disability services: 3 percent
- Increase in individuals utilizing Substance Use Disorder services: 26 percent
