

# Albemarle County, VA

Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

2017



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# **Summary**

The National Citizen Survey  $^{TM}$  (The NCS $^{TM}$ ) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by age, sex, race/ethnicity, length of residency and median household income.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (382 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Across Community Characteristics, few significant differences emerged between the age, sex, race/ethnicity
  and length of residency subgroups. When compared by household income, lower income residents tended to
  rate most aspects within Community Characteristics lower than their counterparts.
- Within Governance, respondents who had lived in the County 11 years or more tended to be less positive compared to those whose tenure was shorter. Residents who identified as white alone, not Hispanic were more pleased with government performance and services residents who identified as Hispanic and/or other race.
- Generally, participation in the community increased with age and income, (e.g., volunteering, participating in a club, talking or visiting with and doing a favor for a neighbor).
- Residents who identified as female, Hispanic and/or other race, short lengths of residency (five years or less), or whose income was between \$50,000 and \$99,999 placed higher importance on Albemarle County services (e.g., recycling center, composting) and were more supportive of tax increases to pay for these services than their counterparts.
- When asked about sources of information about County activities, events and services, women and residents who were Hispanic and/other race favored social media, residents with a longer tenure in the County favored other local media outlets and the youngest residents favored *C-ville Weekly*.
