## About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey ${ }^{\mathrm{TM}}$, Albemarle County conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in J une and data were collected through July 24th, 2017 (see the report, The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Albemarle county, VA 2017). About six weeks into data collection, the County made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the County's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from J uly $17^{\text {th }}$ to J uly 31st, 2017 and 379 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and data have not been weighted to current population estimates of Albemarle County.
