During his time as an engineering specialist and supervisor, he developed the first three-dimensional computer model used to analyze field development strategies and oil recovery for a major oil field in Saudi Arabia. Bob was also able to use his strong analytical skills and experience in engineering to develop a new analytical approach to quantify subterranean rock properties from specialized oil well tests. These results were later published in industry proceedings and journals.

He continued his education at Houston Baptist University, where he obtained an M.B.A. He also earned a post-baccalaureate graduate certification in public management from Virginia Commonwealth University's L.
