# Attachment A: Financial Information for a Selection of Parks & Recreation Facilities

Parks & Recreation manages community centers in Greenwood and Scottsville. The Scottsville Community Center is located in a portion of the old Scottsville Elementary School and is primarily used by four organizations. The Boys & Girls Club offer programs for at-risk youth in the afterschool hours and during the summer in a computer lab, gym, and classroom. The lease for these programs is \$1 per year. JABA hosts the Scottsville Community Center programs for seniors once per week, with no facility charge. Bread of Life hosts a food pantry once per month, with no facility charge. Parks & Recreation hosts several community recreation programs, with no facility charge. Greenwood Community Center is used by Parks & Recreation to offer fee-based recreation classes and also private individuals can rent the facility for meeting space and/or skating parties. Fees collected do not recover the costs of operating or maintaining the building, or depreciation capital improvements.

### Scottsville Community Center (SCC)
