POLICY GOVERNING REQUESTS FOR USE OF
INDUSTRIAL ACCESS FUNDS FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA
TO CONSTRUCT AN INDUSTRIAL ACCESS ROAD

It shall be the policy of the Board of Supervisors of Albemarle County, Virginia, to handle developers' requests for use of Industrial Access Funds from the Commonwealth of Virginia; to construct an Industrial Access Road, on a first-come, first-serve basis, or in the event that more than one request is received concurrently funds to be distributed proportionately, for available funding in any one fiscal year using the following criteria:

1. All property adjoining a proposed industrial access road shall be currently zoned for industrial uses that will qualify under the state's Industrial Access Program.
2. All costs and potential obligations of the program shall be borne by any applicant such that no local funds are in any way involved in any such project.
