RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THAT THE RIVANNA SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY LOWER ITS MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE TIPPING FEE AT THE IVY MATERIAL UTILIZATON CENTER SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION

WHEREAS, the May 4, 2016 Amended and Restated Ivy Material Utilization Center Programs Agreement between the County of Albemarle and the Rivanna Solid Waste Authority (RSWA) provides that the RSWA shall propose any changes to tipping fees for adoption by the RSWA's Board of Directors as requested by majority vote of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that it is in the best interest of the County for the RSWA to lower its Municipal Solid Waste tipping fee at the Ivy Material Utilization Center (MUC) solid waste transfer station to \$55.00 per ton, a level closer to the fee in adjacent counties, in order to make the Ivy MUC more competitive for haulers of solid waste.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that the RSWA propose to the RSWA Board of Directors that it adopt a lower tipping fee of \$55.00 per ton at the Ivy MUC solid waste transfer station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Director of the Facilities and Environmental Services Department to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Rivanna Solid Waste Authority.
