Notes:

(1) Transient Occupancy Tax numbers shown in this table reflect the total of the County's 5% tax on hotel/motel lodgings. Note that only 40% of the annual revenues shown above accrue to the County's *General Fund*.

(2) Unemployment rates are by place of *residence*. The figures shown on this sheet represent the *average monthly unemployment rate* during the twelve month period of the fiscal year. U.S., Virginia, and Albemarle fiscal year unemployment rates are derived from *non* seasonally-adjusted monthly data.

(3) Job numbers include part-time and full-time positions, as well as permament and temporary positions. Jobs are by place of *employment*. The numbers shown on this sheet represent the *average monthly number of jobs* in Albemarle County during the twelve month period of the fiscal year. Data does not include jobs in unclassifed industries. Job totals might not add up exactly due to rounding errors in sub-category calcuations.

(4) The estimated number of jobs for each category in FY 18 is calculated using a Year-Over-Year (YOY) methodology that compares job figures for Q1, Q2, and Q3 of FY 18 and FY 17 respectively and then draws an inference about the Year-End FY 18 jobs numbers. Note that the estimated total number of jobs in the County equals the sum of the estimated values for each category in the "Accommodation and Food Services" through "Wholesale Trade" section of the table; the estimated total number of public sector jobs in Albemarle reflects the sum of the estimated values in the federal, state, and local government categories.

(5) The Average Weekly Wage for each quarter is weighted by the relative number of jobs in each sector and is inflation-adjusted using CPI-U (All Items, 1982-84 = 100). Figures shown on this table reflect FY 18 dollars.

(6) The FY 18 estimated average weekly wage includes the known values for Q1, Q2, and Q3 of FY 18, and an estimated number for Q4 of FY 18. A YOY methodology, as described above in Note 3, generated the Q4 estimated for FY 18.

(7) The FHFA House Price Index (HPI) pertains to the Charlottesville Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), is not seasonally-adjusted (but *is* adjusted for inflation), and reflects all transactions. Index figures reflect FY 18 dollars.
