Construction Activities

Route 29 Solutions Project Details

- The ATSPM work is complete. VDOT has coordinated with the City and County to abandon installation of the adaptive system and instead focus on a performance metrics based system. The City and VDOT are developing an agreement where VDOT will take over operations and maintenance on five signals near the City/County line to ensure continuity of operations across municipal boundaries. The City and VDOT held another coordination meeting on May 3rd to discuss 4 alternative plans for operations and maintenance responsibilities. The performance metric based system is already in operation along the Route 29 corridor in the County. VDOT has taken over operations of the signal at Route 29 and Angus and will be taking over additional signals this year.
- The Hydraulic/Hillsdale South study is complete. The final HPAP meeting was held on July 19, 2018. The SMART SCALE applications were completed by the August deadline. The applications will be scored over the next several months.
