Construction Activities

Route 29 Solutions Project Details

- The ATSPM work is complete. VDOT has coordinated with the City and County to abandon installation of the
 adaptive system and instead focus on a performance metrics based system. The City and VDOT are developing an
 agreement where VDOT will take over operations and maintenance on five signals near the City/County line to
 ensure continuity of operations across municipal boundaries. The City and VDOT held another coordination
 meeting on May 3rd to discuss 4 alternative plans for operations and maintenance responsibilities.
 The performance metric based system is already in operation along the Route 29 corridor in the County. VDOT has
 taken over operations of the signal at Route 29 and Angus and will be taking over additional signals this year.
- The Hydraulic/Hillsdale South study is complete. The final HPAP meeting was held on July 19, 2018. The SMART SCALE applications were completed by the August deadline. The applications were scored and results were made available last month. None of the three applications were recommended for funding.

Bridge Projects

- Route 640 Gilbert's Station Road Bridge Repair State forces anticipated to begin work in March 2019. May be delayed due to delay in getting RR clearance.
- Rte. 810 Blackwell's Hollow Road Superstructure Replacement State forces work anticipated to begin in summer 2019.

Road Projects

- Route 731 Keswick Road Rural Rustic To be completed in spring 2019.
- **Signal rebuild –** Route 743 and Route 657/1455 Work will include reducing the number of signal polses within the intersection, updating existing signals and improving pedestrian facilities.

- Route 1452 Westfield Road Signage review complete. Pending no parking sign installation.

- Route 685 Miller School Road & Route 676 Ownensville Road Through Truck Restriction sent to Charlottesville Residency for public advertisement.

Maintenance Activities
