### (1) Transient Occupancy Tax includes General Fund revenue only.

(2) Unemployment rates are by place of *residence* and are *not* seasonally-adjusted. The figures shown on this sheet represent the *average monthly unemployment rate* during the three month period of the quarter.

(3) Job numbers include part-time and full-time positions, as well as permament and temporary positions. Jobs are by place of *employment*. The numbers shown on this sheet represent the *average monthly number of jobs* in Albemarle County during the quarter. Job totals might not add up exactly due to rounding errors in sub-category calcuations.

(4) The Average Weekly Wage for each quarter is weighted by the relative number of jobs in each sector and is inflation-adjusted using CPI-U (All Items, 1982-84 = 100). The figures shown on this table are in Q1 FY 19 dollars.

(5) The FHFA House Price Index (HPI) pertains to the Charlottesville Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), is not *seasonally*-adjusted (but is adjusted for *inflation*), and reflects all transactions. The index figures shown on this table reflect Q4 FY 19 price levels.

Virginia and Albemarle unemployment rates for the current fiscal year are taken from the Virginia Employment Commission (VEC) LAUS webpage (https://virginiawlmi.com/local-area-unemployment-statistics-laus?page83072=1&size83072=12), accessed October 26, 2019. Figures for prior fiscal years come from previously-published economic indicator reports.

U.S. unemployment rate data for the current fiscal year is taken from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) "Databases, Tables, and Calculators by Subject" webpage (http://www.bls.gov/data/#unemployment), accessed October 26, 2019. Figures for prior fiscal years come from previously-published economic indicator reports.

Albemarle County jobs data and nominal Average Weekly Wage data for the current fiscal year is taken from the VEC's Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) webpage (https://virginiawlmi.com/quarterly-census-of-employment-and-wages-qcew), accessed October 26, 2019. Figures for prior fiscal years come from previously-published economic indicator reports.

Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) data, which is used to calculate the inflation-adjusted average weekly wage and house price index data, is taken from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics website (https://data.bls.gov/cgi-bin/surveymost?cu), accessed October 26, 2019).

Federal Housing Finance Agency HPI data for the Charlottesville MSA is taken from the FHFA website, Quarterly All-Transactions webpage (https://www.fhfa.gov/DataTools/Downloads/Pages/House-Price-Index-Datasets.aspx#qat), accessed October 26, 2019.
