MODIFICATIONS TO PHASE 3 – ALL OTHER PHASE 3 GUIDELINES APPLY

	Proposed Revision
Occupancy at Food Establishments, Wineries, Breweries, and Distilleries (Sec. 4)	Indoors: Occupancy will be limited to 50% of Certificate of Occupancy (CO) occupancy load, with a 50 person limit for those businesses without a CO occupancy load.
Gatherings <i>Planned or spontaneous events for a common purpose</i> (Sec. 5)	Reduce gatherings limit from 250 to 50, except: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Outdoor gatherings at Food Establishments, Wineries, Breweries, and Distilleries• Religious exercise• Weddings• Expressive activities (e.g., demonstrations)
Face Covering Requirement (Sec. 6)	Require face coverings at: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Indoor public places• Outdoor public places without 6' distancing <i>Exclusions: personal residences, personal vehicles, institutions of higher education and other schools, fitness and other exercise facilities, religious institutions, indoor shooting ranges, and the County courthouse buildings</i>
