Occupancy at Food Establishments, Wineries, Breweries, and Distilleries (Sec. 4)	Indoors: Occupancy will be limited to 50% of Certificate of Occupancy (CO) occupancy load, with a 50 person limit for those businesses without a CO occupancy load.
<b>Gatherings</b> Planned or spontaneous events for a common purpose (Sec. 5)	<ul> <li>Reduce gatherings limit from 250 to 50, except:</li> <li>Outdoor gatherings at Food Establishments, Wineries, Breweries, and Distilleries</li> <li>Religious exercise</li> <li>Weddings</li> <li>Expressive activities (e.g., demonstrations)</li> </ul>
<b>Face Covering</b> Requirement (Sec. 6)	<ul> <li>Require face coverings at: <ul> <li>Indoor public places</li> <li>Outdoor public places without 6' distancing</li> </ul> </li> <li>Exclusions: personal residences, personal vehicles, institutions of higher education and other schools, fitness and other exercise facilities, religious institutions, indoor shooting ranges, and the County courthouse buildings</li> </ul>
