BACKGROUND: The Environmental Compliance Manager initiated this report in 2015 to provide updates to the Board and County Executives on activities related to environmental compliance, pollution prevention and energy management. As a consequence of the formation of the Department of Facilities and Environmental Services and the Environmental Service Division, staff has expanded the breadth of the report to include activities related to water quality protection, infrastructure management, and solid waste and recycling.

STRATEGIC PLAN: Natural Resources Stewardship: Thoughtfully protect and manage Albemarle County's ecosystems and natural resources in both the rural and development areas to safeguard the quality of life of current and future generations. Infrastructure Investment: Prioritize, plan, and invest in critical infrastructure that responds to past and future changes and improves the capacity to serve community needs.
