<b>Title:</b>	<p>Electoral Board and Registrar-Proposed New Voting Precincts and Voting Locations. To receive comments on its intent to adopt an ordinance to amend sections 2-101, 2-103, 2-105, and 2-106 of Article I, Elections, of Chapter 2, Administration, of the Albemarle County Code. The proposed ordinance would: Consolidate the Belfield Precinct into the Jack Jouett Precinct; Establish Jack Jouett Middle School, 210 Lambs Lane, Charlottesville, Virginia 22901 as the polling place for the consolidated Jack Jouett Precinct; Divide the current Free Bridge Precinct into the Free Bridge Precinct and the Pantops Precinct; Establish Broadus Memorial Baptist Church, 1525 Stony Point Road, Charlottesville, Virginia 22911 as the Pantops Precinct polling place; Divide the current Cale Precinct into the Cale Precinct and the Biscuit Run Precinct; Establish Monticello High School, 1400 Independence Way, Charlottesville, Virginia 22902 as the Biscuit Run Precinct polling place; Remove a portion of the current Crozet Precinct and a portion of the current Brownsville Precinct to create the Mechums River Precinct; and Establish Western Albemarle High School, 5941 Rockfish Gap Turnpike, Crozet, Virginia 22932 as the Mechums River Precinct polling place.</p>
