**Title:** Ordinance to Amend County Code Chapter 4, Animals. To receive public comment on its intent to adopt an ordinance to amend Chapter 4, Animals, of the Albemarle County Code by amending County Code § 4-319, Frequent or continuous sounds by animals are prohibited. Section 4-319 makes it unlawful and a nuisance for an owner or custodian of an animal to allow the animal to frequently or for a continued duration howl, bark, or make other excessive or continuous sounds which are audible on the property of a complainant in the County. There four classes of animal sounds exempt from Section 4-319, one of which is sounds "created by any animal located on a parcel five acres or more in size that is zoned Rural Areas district." The proposed ordinance would eliminate this exemption.
